







The setting: Lausanne

EIPEN invites you to take part in the 2017 Conference in Switzerland. Lausanne lies on the banks of Lake Geneva. It boasts an impressive Old Town, and prime access to the great outdoors, situated in the middle of Switzerland's wine region. The city faces the French Alps, with the Jura mountains to its north-west. It has a rich cultural offering, many green spaces, and a rapid public transport system. With several institutes of higher education (La Source, HESAV, Polytechnic Federal School, and UNIL University of Lausanne), clinics, and a highly specialized university hospital, Lausanne offers a rich academic resource for health care.





The venue: La Source

The host of the conference is the first established non-religious institute of higher education fur nursing in the world (1859). It now offers several specialized study programmes and is member of GEPI, the health interprofessional initiative of Lausanne. The institute is situated in the centre of the city. The campus buildings have spacious and comfortable rooms, equipped with modern technology for high-quality teaching and learning.

EIPEN conferences combine scientific and innovative content with opportunities for networking. The conference language is English but for keynote presentations simultaneous translation in French is foreseen.
